Enroll in the district's insurance program today:

- 1. Log into http://one2onerisk.com
- 2. Click on "Enroll My Device"
- 3. Select Pennsylvania, McKeesport Area School District, Pre-K, and the 2021-2022 School Year
- 4. Enter your Participant ID: Your Child's Number
- 5. Choose your payment option. If you are using a credit card continue the registration. If you want a "Prepaid Cash Card" stop the registration, bring \$20.00 to your building's main office. Once receiving the card you can complete the registration by entering the access number on the back of the card.

District policy requires students in grades 3-12 to opt in to an insurance policy if they would like to utilize a district chromebook. The fee is \$20.00 per student and can be purchased through the District's insurance program's website at http://one2onerisk.com. For families who cannot or do not wish to enroll with a personal debit or credit card, insurance vouchers can be purchased for the \$20.00 enrollment cost.
